Conditions of Entry

- Team sponsorship/marketing is limited to apron/tshirt/hat and 3x3 metre marquee only. No extra banners allowed.
- \$200 budget for cost of food per team.
- Sponsorship of teams cannot be in direct opposition to the Event's sponsor. The final decision regarding sponsors is to be made by the Committee.
- All teams will be supplied with an equal starting budget from the Committee, in which to purchase provisions for the Cook Off;
- Entry allows one or a number of people to compete in the Koorlong Camp Oven Cook Off as a team. No more than three (3) persons will be allowed into the cooking arena as a team at any given time. Teams must be made up of a maximum of three (3) cooks and a maximum of two (2) support crew making a total of five (5) members to a team;
- All teams are entitled to bring a 6x4ft trailer (single axle) into the cooking arena and leave it there during the course of the competition. All cars are to be left outside of the arena;
- All teams must be at the Koorlong Hall and ready to commence (gates shut) by 9am;
- Meals to be served at your preparation and cooking area. Serving table to be undercover ie, gazebos, beach umbrella, tarp etc. No hold down pegs in to ground.
- All dishes must be cooked in camp ovens, bedouries or camp ovens as supplied by the teams;
- Each team is to supply their own hot coals/cooking fuel;
- All teams must cater as though they are cooking for 20 people but keep in mind that portions will be served to 200 people (ie don't use portion limited items such as chicken drumsticks etc)
- Teams must prepare and serve three (3 courses) – entrée, main meal and dessert;
- All teams are encouraged to display their menu during the competition and advise if any meals contain allergens – ie nuts/fish/gluten;
- Competitors will be given a specified time limit to complete the cooking and final presentation prior to serving;
- Prizes will be awarded/given at the end of the day;
- All teams are responsible for cleaning up their cooking area upon completion of the competition;
- There are a limited number of team entries available. An entry will be deemed confirmed upon receipt of the entry form by Friday 21st June;
- Strictly NO DOGS allowed on the Hall premises.
- All teams are to take the competition in the spirit that it's intended – have fun, be safe, cheat fairly (☺)
